## Battle Archery

Age: Grade 2 +

Learn how to shoot a recurve bow then head into battle with your classmates. Battle Archery is the exciting combination of archery and dodgeball.

Players are geared up with bows, face masks, and arm guards, ready to fire foam-tipped arrows at the opposing team.

Our equipment can be used in gymnasiums or playing fields.

**Mission** - Improve focus under pressure and Increase hand eye coordination.



## Hover Archery

Age: Kinder +

Using inflatable archery targets and special foam tipped arrows, Hover Archery is an easy way to bring entertainment and play anywhere.

Learn how to shoot a recurve bow with our skilled instructors and high quality equipment.

**Mission** - Control breathing, concentration and nervousness.

Customized lesson plans that follow Archery Canada PLO's, that are great for beginners and those looking to enhance their archery skills.

Learn about breath control, stance, goal setting, and much more.

Our soft foam tipped arrows are suitable for gyms, fields, and community halls.

## Bubble Ball

Age: Kinder +

Bubble Ball is the exciting, action-packed sport you've been waiting for! Players wear an inflatable bubble that covers above the head to the knees, allowing students to run, roll and bounce into their friends.

Suitable for Gymnasiums and grass playing fields.

**Mission** - Improve cardio vascular health, and class participation through alternative play.



## Imagination Playground

Age: 2+ years



Unleash your creative side! Build, play, and explore with Stellar Play's Imagination Playground. Children will work collaboratively to create structures and play facilitated games and challenges. With a focus on problem solving, focus, and creativity, children will be challenged to create and communicate!

## Forest Laser Tag

Age: Grade 4 +

Strategize and work together to complete missions and defeat their opponents. Experience the heart pumping thrill of playing laser tag in Maple Ridge's, beautiful UBC Research Forest, or at your school!

Team challenges include Capture the Flag, VIP, Domination, Survival, and many more.

**Mission** - Develop fine-and gross motor skills and communication.



## Archery + Play!

Age: Grade K-5

Experience Archery in a safe, fun, and educational setting. This program is the perfect way to introduce students to Archery.

Students will train with Stellar Play's Archery Instructors using foam tipped arrows. Students will build on their archery knowledge and learn a variety of skills including: shooting sequence, form, mental preparation, anchoring, and much more!

**Mission** - Improve breath control, concentration and goal setting.



## Forest Rangers

Age: Kinder +

Duration: 6 Weeks / Pro-D Camp

Learn what it takes to play in the wilderness safely and with confidence.

Discover how you can become a responsible, self-reliant, and adventurous visitor of the British Columbia backcountry by learning a variety of skills including: geocaching, shelter building, compass navigation, trip planning, the ten essentials, knot tying and much more.

**Mission** - Improve critical thinking and communication skills, and confidence.

## Action Camp

Age: Grade 3+

Duration: 6 Weeks / Pro-D Camp

This program is a combination of team building and competitive fun.

Students will compete in a verity of different games and challenges during this jam packed, action filled program. Students will enter bubbles competing in soccer challenges; they will learn how to use a bow and have a dodgeball-like battle using foam tipped arrows.

**Mission** - Improve communication, teamwork, cooperation, and leadership style.

## Survival Series: Race to Survive

Age: Grade 3+

Learn the foundations of survival in this immersive team challenge. Students have been "left behind" and must find the hiking essentials using compasses to build their camp, "survive the night", and successfully call for help.

This workshop is designed as a 1.5 hour program to introduce navigating with compasses, shelter building, and the skills needed to play in the wilderness safely and with confidence.

**Mission** - Develop responsible, self-reliant, and adventurous stewards of the wilderness.



## Survival Series: Navigation

Age: Grade 3+

Learn the foundations needed to navigate in the wilderness using compasses, GPS units, and your natural surroundings.

This workshop is designed as a 1.5 hour program which guides students in an orienteering challenge and Geocache treasure hunt.

**Mission** - Develop confident and self-aware hikers that can navigate under pressure.



## Survival Series: Shelter Building

Age: Grade K+



Discover the skills necessary to build a variety of shelter types including: A-frames, Lean-to, C fly wedge, and much more.

Students will learn the knots needed to build a sturdy shelter using provided and natural materials.

This workshop is designed as a 1.5 hour program which will cover a variety of shelter types, and knot tying.

**Mission** - Increase positive socialization between peers, and critical thinking skills.



## Is it safe?

Like all sports and recreation, there is always risk involved. To minimize risk, Facilitators go over rules and boundaries before starting to ensure you have a great time playing! Equipment is inspected thoroughly before all programs, and fitted to students individually.

## Do you take a deposit?


Yes. We require a 50% non-refundable deposit to hold your date and time. If you decide to reschedule, that deposit carries over to your new event.
